Discussion of 2025 Plant Control Plan

Rick Buteyn, Progressive Companies distributed the May 10, 2025, Long Lake Treatment Map reporting the first herbicide treatment scheduled for May 29th for Eurasian Milfoil and Curly Leaf Pond Weed will be “a little liter” than the 2024 initial treatment. Estimated costs are \$21,000 leaving \$15,000 for future spot treatments. Treatment around docks for Starry Stone Wort will be done at the end of June. Harvesting by PLM is scheduled for the week of July 14th. This year the DEQ is requiring permits to harvest, PLM will make the application. Special attention will be given to the northwestern end of the lake, in addition ½ acre will be harvested in the sand bar area.

Discussion of 2026 Assessment

The three-year annual special assessment of \$343 Lakefront and \$257 Backlot for the improvement of Long Lake expired in 2025. A proposed annual budget of \$92,000 for three years was presented to the board, after discussion the board decided to increase the period to five years. The estimated annual special assessment would increase to \$384 Lakefront and \$343 Backlot. A public hearing is scheduled for July 19, 2025, at 9:00 am at the Orleans Township Hall.
