The following resolution was offered by member S. Wirtz and seconded by member P. Knoerl

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the improvement program for Long Lake; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Long Lake Improvement Board to proceed with implementation of a five-year improvement program consisting of aquatic plant control, lake management consulting, water quality sampling, information and education, and administration and contingency for Long Lake with an annual budget of \$92,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Lake Board hereby determines that the proposed improvements are practical, and it confirms its intent to proceed with the improvements.
2. The Lake Board hereby approves the lake improvement plan and the estimate of costs for the improvements.
3. This resolution shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Ionia County. The project shall not, thereafter, be subject to attack except in an action brought in a court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days after publication.

# Resolution Confirming Special Assessment Roll and Directing the Collection of Special Assessments for Improvements to Long Lake

At a special meeting of the Long Lake Improvement Board held at 9:00 am on July 19, 2025 at Orleans Township Hall, 3077 Palmer Road, Orleans, Michigan.

PRESENT: Paul K, Scott W., Michelle D., Robert R.

ABSENT: Mike Keast

The following resolution was offered by member Paul Kneer and seconded by member Scott W.

WHEREAS, the Lake Board, after due and legal notice, has reviewed the Special Assessment Roll prepared for the purpose of assessing the cost of certain lake improvements to Long Lake against benefiting properties; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Board deems said Special Assessment Roll to be fair and equitable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Long Lake Special Assessment Roll in the amount of \$462,500, is hereby confirmed.
2. The assessments in said Special Assessment Roll shall be payable in five annual installments with the first installment of \$92,500 to be due on December 1, 2025, and payable without penalty through February 14, 2026. Subsequent installments of \$92,500 shall be due on or before the 1st day of December of each year thereafter and are payable without penalty through the 14th day of February of each year thereafter.
3. The assessments made in said Special Assessment Roll are hereby ordered and directed to be collected, and the Clerk of Orleans Township shall deliver said Special Assessment Roll to the Township Treasurer, with his/her warrant attached, commanding the treasurer to collect the assessments therein in accordance with the directions of the Lake Board, and the treasurer is directed to collect the amounts assessed as the same become due.
